Help With Funding

The basic proposal-writing rules and strategies are always the same, regardless of the size of the grant for which you're applying. The bottom-line requirements for writing a successful proposal are the ability to read and follow instructions, simple math skills and

an idea worth funding. Most of the work on your proposal happens before you start writing. Once you've identified a funding opportunity, you must research your project idea, the grant and the funding agency. You are far more likely to be awarded a grant if your

project objectives closely match the agency's mission and the purpose of the grant. When you demonstrate this compatibility in your proposal, along with knowledge of the solution options and the funders, you build valuable credibility.



Create a "skim-able" proposal with graphs or diagrams, bold section headers and frequent paragraph breaks to visually divide the text. Closely follow any formatting guidelines in the call for proposals. Generally, you should use 12-point Times New Roman type, with no "fancy" fonts, and highlight important text with bold, not underlining.

- PROVE that your project is needed with independent evidence/support.
- Show why your solution is worthy and meets what the funders prioritises
- State how you will prove your project is working and will add real value.
- Outline how you will clearly measure results and evaluate its success.
- Show the plans you have to sustain the project after the funding ends.
